An after-school library program for children who could benefit from extra reading support.

*Grades 1-5

Meetings Include:

Cozy Atmoshpere ~ There's nothing better than cuddling up with a stuffed animal in the library after a long day at school. We will even provide the stuffed animals!

Engaging Books Read to Your Child ~ The library staff will choose a book and read 1-2 chapters aloud. At the end of the meeting, we will bookmark it and pick up where we left off the following week.

Art Projects ~ Every week, after we read, the kids will have an opportunity to do an art project that helps them practice retelling the story. The project will last the entire length of the book. When we finish the book, they can take their projects home to share with their families!

Snacks ~ Everyone needs a snack after school! The kids will munch while we read to them. Food allergies? We will get all that information before the first meeting, so we can make sure your kids are safe and comfortable.

At-home Incentive Program ~ Every participant will go home from the first meeting with three things:

- A bookmark reading log so they can keep track of the books they read at home. Any book they
 read on their reading level counts!
- January's charm They will receive a charm for each month. If they attend one meeting for a specific month, they earn that month's charm. They can also earn a "10" charm for every 10 books they read and log on their bookmarks.
- A ball chain necklace to which they can add all the charms they earn.
